The Church begins a very intense season that offers us an opportunity to grow closer to the only Savior of the world, Jesus Christ. The word "Lent" means "springtime"; in other words, we are called to have the blossom of faith come alive in our souls after the winter of sin and death. In order to help you to prepare for Lent we have added a Mass at Saint Margaret Church, Monday through Thursday at 7:00 PM during the weeks of Lent. On Fridays, at 5:45 PM, there will be a soup and a discussion on the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy in the Ministry Center followed by the Stations of the Cross at Saint Margaret Church at 7:30 PM. See the website for Lenten schedule held at Infant Jesus Parish. Anyone over fourteen is to refrain from eating meat every Friday during Lent. The traditional program of Lent is outlined by Our Lord: Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving. Please spend more time in prayer during this time, visiting the chapel which is open every day and frequently attending Mass daily. Pray the Holy Rosary and Divine Mercy Chaplet. One should go to confession to be rid of the dirt of sin in their lives. Give up frivolous foods and activities during this time focusing on the Passion of the Lord Jesus. As for almsgiving, give of yourselves to others in charitable acts and words. Pray about giving to the House of Charity. I am so proud of our parish in that you are supporting the Infant Jesus Parish ever stronger in these times. Our collection has been so generous and I beg the Lord to bless your sharing what you have with your spiritual home. May the Lord grant you many graces during Lent as we move towards the glorious season of Easter!

Mrs. Casey Smith

Fifth Grade

Mrs. Smith has taught at St. Margaret Regional School for 7 years. She especially enjoys reading the novel "Number the Stars" by Lois Lowry with her students. She explains to the students how this story teaches about the value of friendship and bravery during difficult times. "Number the Stars" is a story about a Jewish family's harrowing escape from Copenhagen during World War II and the Holocaust. Although considered historical fiction, this story is based upon a real life account. The fifth grade students take a trip to see the play once they have finished reading the story. During the month of February, Mrs. Smith talks with her students about the importance of daily prayer. They learn about the basic forms of prayer and that Jesus is the ultimate example of how and when we should pray. Mrs. Smith will also be teaching her students about the season of Lent and Jesus' sacrifice for us as they read the Stations of the Cross. 


