Dear Friends in Christ,



As you can see below, there is a letter from Father Odien, our Vicar for Clergy, concerning my recent evaluation. Thank you to those who made suggestions for me to improve and for the overwhelming compliments you wrote about me. I am truly humbled and know that it is a joy to serve you. You are in my heart and prayers always. It is important to announce that we have received permission from the diocese to proceed to fix the roof this spring. We held off as long as possible to save money. The roof will cost approximately \$250,000.00 (it's hard to even write that number!). It will be done correctly this time and you will find out more information as we move towards the spring concerning the impact on our activity in the church. Finally, please give your donation to the House of Charity. We are way behind where we were this time last year. This is so important in our fulfillment of the Gospel mandate to serve the poor. Our goal is \$160,694.00 and we are currently at \$69,690.00 so we have a way to go. Last year at this time, we were at \$102,000.00. I have given my donation, so know that I do not ask anything I would not do myself. It was heard in my evaluation numerous times that we are in this together in keeping our parish strong. Thank you so much for this sentiment!

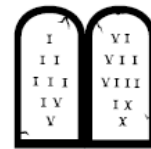

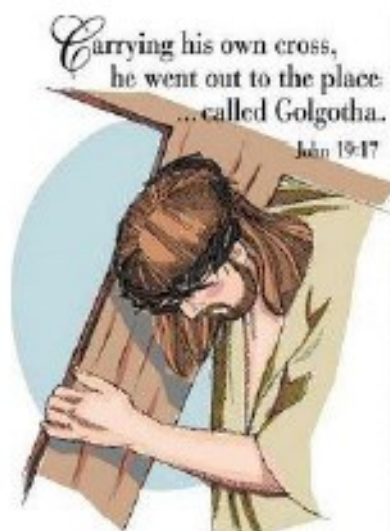

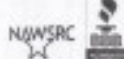
