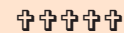

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,



What an outpouring welcoming I received last weekend from all of you at the Infant Jesus Family. I am truly touched by your kindness and support which is a good start for me. This weekend I will be celebrating Masses at St. John Vianney Church, I just cannot wait to see our brothers and sisters there.

Being my first week in the parish, everything is so new, fresh, and different to me. First, I have to learn about the keys to all the buildings, about the existing ministries in the parish and their activity schedules, and of course there are still many things that I need to listen, observe, and study as well. However, there is one essential thing that I would like to learn and listen to is your hearts. Please let me know anything about your feelings, your thoughts, your observations, your concerns whether it is personal or of the parish.

In the Gospel of this weekend, the young man asked Jesus: "Who is my neighbor?" In responding to the man's question, Jesus gave a clear explanation and application by laying out the circumstance of the robbed victim, the priest, the Levite, and the Samaritan. In this situation, the priest saw the victim but he passed by because he was in a hurry on the way to the temple and also the "temple business" was more important than anything else even caring for the victim. The Levite saw the victim and passed by too because of the "Levitical law" that forbade him to touch the "seemed to be dead body" when he was on the way to offer sacrifice in the temple. Only the Samaritan stopped and took good care of the victim out of his love and compassion. Both you and I should take this Gospel message into our hearts and as Jesus said: "Go and do the same". What is more important in this life? The earthly things are here today and gone Tomorrow or the things which last forever? And what are things that last forever? "Mercy and compassion I desired and not sacrifice" said Jesus. Whatever we do: for family or parish, we should keep the word of Jesus in mind: "Mercy I desire and not sacrifice."
