Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

With total faith and trust in God's providential care, I believe that God the Holy Spirit has inspired Bishop Sullivan in his decision in sending me here as Pastor of the Infant Jesus Family. With a humble spirit and joyful heart, I am so grateful for this divine providential assignment. My greatest challenge for this assignment is that I have to follow the footsteps of a "living Saint", Father Szolack, whom I have great admiration. I promise that, despite my weaknesses and shortcomings, I will do my best to continue building up Fr. Szolack's legacy and spreading and nurturing this earthly Kingdom of God at the Infant Jesus Parish.



As a new Pastor, I would like to share with you a short summary about myself. I was born and raised in a family of eleven children in Vietnam. In 1975, the communist regime from North Vietnam took over South Vietnam where we lived. After years of living under the communist control without freedom, especially freedom of worship, my parents finally decided to escape from Vietnam for the sake of our Catholic faith.

In 1986, my whole family got into a small boat and headed to the unknown destination on the Pacific Ocean. The three day and four night journey was very rough and dangerous due to the strong storms and enormous waves, our small boat was almost to the point of sinking, everyone on the boat was screaming, crying, and praying desperately. Thanks be to God for His love and mercy, my family finally was rescued by the Malaysian coast guards and was brought to the refugee camp there. After a year living in the refugee camp, we were received into this "promised land", God bless America. I just could not thank God enough in this life for all the good and miraculous things He has done for my family and for me personally.

Living in this free country and with the help of God, I was able to pursue my Priestly vocation which would have been impossible if I was still in Vietnam. In 1998, after years of study and formation, I was ordained to the Priesthood. Being a priest for eighteen years, I have never stopped thanking God and the people whom God had sent into my life and my ministry. It is a blessing, a joy to share the ministerial Priesthood of Jesus Christ, and a true fulfillment to serve His people.

During this Jubilee Year of Mercy, Pope Francis has called each one of us to recognize God's mercy in our lives and share it with our families and our parish community. The Biblical word for mercy is "hesed" which means entering "one's chaos, suffering, pain, sorrow, hopelessness, even sinfulness and death". The Infant Jesus entered into our fallen world, our sinful humanity, not to condemn but to redeem, to heal, to reconcile, and to "divinize" us by making us heirs of His heavenly Kingdom.

As a Priest of Jesus Christ and a spiritual leader of the parish, I am asking you to please help me to fulfill my Priestly mission entrusted to me by allowing me to enter into your "hesed", your chaos, your sorrow, your suffering, your pain, your frustration, your brokenness, your hopelessness, your rejection, or your addiction. In this way, with the grace of God and the guidance of the Holy Spirit, I might be able to share and to live the divine mercy of Jesus Christ, the High Priest, in my Priestly ministry. I am looking forward to serving you and to making our parish community a community of love and mercy for all.

May the Infant Jesus' love and mercy inspire all of us to love and to be merciful as our heavenly Father is merciful.
