Dear Friends in Christ,



This weekend, our nation celebrates Fathers Day. We wish all of our fathers every blessing on this day. The Church offers us a beautiful model of fatherhood in Saint Joseph. I was visiting a little wooden chapel and saw one of my favorite statues of Saint Joseph. This statue shows the little Jesus being snuggled into the neck of Joseph who is beaming and the baby Jesus is laughing with joy. The love between the two is very beautiful. I also love a painting of Saint Joseph which shows the Blessed Mother asleep next to a fire and Saint Joseph is walking the baby Jesus to put Him to sleep. Yes, fatherhood is underestimated. Fathers Day is relatively new, having been founded in 1910. It began when a young woman heard her preacher talk about the virtues of motherhood. She lost her mother at a young age and her father raised she and her five siblings on his own. The young lady said that we needed to honor the fathers. Most of us heard when we were little, "Wait until your father gets home" or "Do you want me to call your father?" At the time we would be seized with fear. My father was a tough policeman, yet he never hit me once. Why? I was hardly an angel. It was because he had mastered the *look!* Only dads can give a look that would stop you right in your tracks. I now realize how right he was: "Don't speak in that tone", "Did you not hear your mother?" "Is that how you mow a lawn?" I also remember the *other* "look": getting my first job or being ordained to the priesthood. I thank my heavenly Father for my earthly father; I hope that you can do the same. If not, pray for your father whether on earth or on the other side. People call me "Father" and every day I can only pray that I am up to the task. Happy Fathers Day to all our beloved dads!

### WELCOME MISSIONARIES



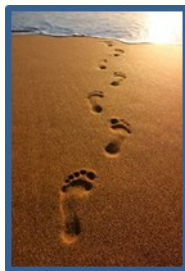


