### Dear Friends in Christ,

From the

This past Thursday, our parish celebrated the Sacrament of Confirmation at Infant Jesus Parish. Bishop Sullivan visited our parish to confirm his parishioners in the faith. It is always an honor to have the bishop visit the parish, I am pleased to celebrate this important milestone in the life of our young people. The Vatican II's Dogmatic Constitution on the Church states that Catholics "are more perfectly bound to the Church by the Sacrament of Confirmation and the Holy Spirit endows them with special strength so that they are more strictly obliged to spread and defend the faith, both by word and deed, as true witnesses of Christ" (Par. 11). I once read an article that said our young people by and large do not see going to Mass as essential to their living their faith in God. While one must watch polls, it is distressing to hear this news, if it is true. If they only knew Whom they are missing! As babies, those to be Confirmed were given extraordinary gifts: Wisdom, Knowledge, Understanding, Fortitude, Counsel, Piety and Fear of the Lord. Too often, like many gifs they may be cast aside...unused. Confirmation strengthens and stirs these gifts into a power for immense charity for God and neighbor. Our Confirmandi gave service to experience what it means to give without receiving; to experience the grace of imitating Jesus "Who came not to be served, but to serve." Our young adults are very good and are very much loved by God. They will jump at the chance to give of themselves. We need to provide the opportunity and the example. Please pray for those Confirmed that they will live their life in Christ to the fullest. We are all called to live an intense spiritual life that is lived out in the Spiritual and Corporal Works of Mercy.
