#### Dear Friends in Christ,

Recently, our Holy Father, Pope Benedict XVI, at a general audience at Castel Gandolfo said, "Silence is the environmental condition that most favors contemplation, listening to God and medi-



tation. The very fact of experiencing silence and allowing ourselves to be 'filled,' so to speak, with silence, disposes us to prayer." The one thing that is needed for deep prayer is silence as indicated by the Holy Father. One of the sad things that have come about in recent years at church is the chatter before and after Mass. How often people do not even attempt to subdue their voice while walking into church or when sitting in the pew, waiting for Mass to start, there is talking about the Phillies, the weather, gossip, etc. The one left out of the conversation is the Lord! He is ignored and it's His house! We should immediately quiet ourselves as we walk into church, bless ourselves with Holy Water, greet our Lord by kneeling at our pew and then remain in silent prayer until the Mass starts. Greet your neighbor outside the church. This includes after Mass. Unbelievably, I have seen people trying to make an act of thanksgiving after Mass and people will stand right by them arranging their date for the diner! Most interestingly are those who leave Mass early (that's another issue!) who give a big "goodbye" or worse yet, hold a conversation with the ushers as they leave. The ushers need to be in the church and praying also, not having to wish the "escapees from Mass" a loud farewell. Hushed silence before and after Mass is out of respect for the Most Blessed Sacrament and out of concern for one's devout fellow parishioner who desires to pray. For some, this is their only time to be silent in the Lord's Real Presence. Some people come to Mass with very heavy burdens and need time to discuss things with the Lord. The party atmosphere is not conducive to meditation. For the faithful parishioner who comes to Mass every week, quiet in both of our churches and at daily Mass in the Chapel must be kept. Lest one believe that this is merely my opinion, I am speaking not only my own concerns, but fellow parishioners who have complained to me that it is very hard to pray in church with all the chatter. People will think that perhaps I am being the party pooper, but the Mass is sacred and as our society becomes ever more disrespectful, let our churches be the last place lacking in devotion. Blessed Teresa of Calcutta reminds us "We need to find God, and he cannot be found in noise and restlessness. God is the friend of silence. See how nature - trees, flowers, grass- grows in silence; see the stars, the moon and the sun, how they move in silence... We need silence to be able to touch souls."

#### **CLASSROOM HIGHLIGHT**

Mrs. Ellie Cordner Second Grade Teacher

Mrs. Cordner has been teaching at St. Margaret Regional School for 16 years. In spring, she especially enjoys giving her students an opportunity to watch carefully as caterpillars in their butterfly habitat go through metamorphosis and hatch into butterflies. Second grade is an important year for sacrament preparation. Mrs. Cordner helps her students to prepare for First Penance and First Holy Communion. She teaches them about the grace they receive from our Lord's forgiveness and the blessings they receive through His Body and Blood. She has each student creatively decorate a felt square that represents them, their family and their faith. Mrs. Cordner then connects the squares to create a class Communion Quilt that is displayed in the school hallway during the month of May. Mrs. Cordner helps her students make rosaries. The students learn the Mysteries of the Rosary and how to pray the Rosary. She explains to her students that the month of May is dedicated to our Holy Mother and invites them to write original prayers to our Blessed Mother.
