Mrs. Ramsay has been teaching at St. Margaret Regional School for 12 years. She enjoys bringing learning to life for her students through a multitude of interactive activities. One activity that excites her class is called "Edible Adjectives." Students have an opportunity to use their five senses to describe different foods provided by Mrs. Ramsay. The students work in groups to practice using adjectives that creatively describe what they taste. Mrs. Ramsay invites parents to help with this *motivating* and *inspiring* language arts activity. During the early part of the school year, students learn the Act of Contrition with the help of former second grade students who volunteer to teach them the words and meaning of this very special prayer. Mrs. Ramsay's class typically takes a few moments each day to power-up with a morning snack. On Tuesdays, they enjoy "2 Snack Tuesdays." During the season of Lent, the students give up their second snack as a way to fast and pray during this solemn season of the church. Mrs. Ramsay makes a small crown of thorns for each student to take home and keep as a reminder of what Jesus wore for each of us. As they prepare for the sacrament of First Holy Communion in May, the students work very hard to better understand their faith and the sacrifice Jesus made for them. 




