Dear Friends in Christ,

From the

This weekend our children in Second Grade received Holy Communion for the first time. What a special time for them and their families! These little ones remind us of our own call to receive Holy Communion with love and devotion. Henry Hardinge Menzies, AIA, writes, "A Protestant was visiting a Catholic church accompanied by his Catholic friend, and after entering, he was admiring the beauty of the architecture and decorations. He was particularly impressed with the altar and the tabernacle on top which was surrounded by angels and many candles. He asked his Catholic friend, "And what's in that box there on the table?" The Catholic replied, "Jesus Christ himself is really present in that box. Our faith tells us that." There was stunned silence. Finally the Protestant said, "If I believed that, I would crawl down this aisle on my knees!"" The Catholic Church has the Real Presence in Her midst and we can be so careless, even callous towards our Lord. What are we to do? We should examine our comportment before the Holy Sacrament on all levels. Firstly, if we have missed Mass intentionally, we must go to confession before receiving the Blessed Sacrament, otherwise it is a sacrilege. Do we genuflect (bend down on one knee) upon our entrance at a Catholic Church? Are we silent in Church in a hushed awe before our Beloved or do we chat in the aisle or speak to our neighbor in unnecessary conversation? Even the way we receive Our Lord speaks so much. The Minister states the "Body of Christ" (not using our name or any other additions) and we, at times, respond little beyond a mumble: "Amen." The norm in the Catholic Church is to receive Holy Communion on the tongue, but a permission was given to various Bishop's Conferences to receive the Body of Christ in the hand. In the United States, we are permitted to receive in the hand. If we are going to receive in the hand, our hands should be clean (obviously people who work with ink and automobiles are a different case), without phone numbers, peace signs, etc., written on the palm and if the hand is gloved it will not be placed on the palm. One hand should be placed under the other always. Never receive with one hand and then shift it to the other because you are carrying a baby, a pocketbook, hat or cane. If you cannot receive with one hand under the other, one should receive Our Lord on the tongue. Also, our hand should be flat. If you need to hold the Sacred Host in place with your thumb, you are not receiving correctly. It is so painful at times to see the reception of Communion in such strange ways. This especially goes for children. The clutching, grab makes one blanch. A mere 30% of Catholics reportedly believe that the sacrament of Holy Communion is actually the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of our Lord and Savior. I get chills even writing the results of that pole. If, by God's grace, we are part of the 30%, then let us ramp up our expressions of love for Him by what we wear, how we speak in whispers in church, receiving Him with devotion and in a State of Grace.


