Dear Young People of Infant Jesus Family,

This week, we are joining with all the dioceses around the nation to pray for vocations as we are celebrating National Vocations Awareness Week. We are praying for young men and women to be open to the voice of Jesus who is calling them to serve in the ministry of the Priesthood or Religious



Life. As a Priest myself, I just cannot thank God enough for calling me and allowing me to serve Him as another-Christ to others. Personally, I wanted to be a Priest because I recognized that there was only one life to live in this world; therefore I had to live it to the fullest and live it joyfully. However, I had been asking myself: How could I live my life joyfully and fully? Finally, I found the "Prayer of St. Francis of Assisi" which inspired me and had a great impact upon my decision to become a Priest.

"Lord, make me an instrument of your peace; where there is hatred, let me show love; where there is injury; pardon; where there is doubt, faith; where there is despair, hope; where there is darkness, light; where there is sadness, joy. O Divine Master, grant that I may not so much seek to be consoled as to console; to be understood as to understand; to be loved as to love: for it is in giving that we receive, it is in pardoning that we are pardoned, and it is in dying that we are born to eternal life."

I have found this "Prayer" so true that "giving is receiving". Indeed, since I have given my whole life to serve God in the ministry of the Priesthood, I had received so much love, joy, and fulfilment from God and from the people whom I had served. The love, joy, and fulfillment of bringing Jesus to others, of helping people to find themselves in Christ again after they were lost. The love, joy, and fulfillment of sharing the loving mercy, compassion, and forgiveness of God to the lost, the hopeless, the sorrowful, the broken, and the despair. By living the life of the Priesthood of Jesus Christ and by doing the Priestly ministry, I have felt so rewarded and so fulfilled every single day. Everyday, I find a good reason for my being, a meaningful purpose to serve, and a heart filled with joy and satisfaction. Everyday the Prayer of St. Francis resounds in my heart: "Lord make me an instrument of your peace..." My young people: be open, be courageous, and not be afraid to say yes to Jesus's call. Like the Angel Gabriel said: "nothing is impossible with God", Jesus will make you capable, he will make you lovable, and He will make you a person you can believe in. You will feel the Priestly life so fulfilling, and your life will be so worth living every single minute. - *Fr. Joe Pham*
