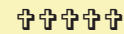

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,



This weekend marks the 15th year of the unspeakable tragedy, an act of evil that our nation will never forget. It is the wound that will never heal, the scar that will never fade, the horrible act that destroyed thousands of innocent lives, it hurt thousands of hearts, and it changed thousands of lives forever. September 11 tragedy did not just occur only in our country; it has happened in Syria, in France, in Iraq, in Afghanistan, and around the world. How can we prevent history from repeating itself? Revenge, retaliation, or “an eye for an eye, a tooth for a tooth” is not a solution, it cannot stop this cycle of evil.
