

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



As you know, we replaced the roof of St. Margaret's Church with a new one a few months ago. However, during the process of roofing replacement, a number of 1x6 tongue and groove hardwood ceiling boards became dislodged and fell from the ceiling. These ceiling boards were originally installed with construction adhesive and staples. Therefore, in order to secure the boards to make sure of a safe environment for worshippers, the Buildings and Grounds Committee have strongly recommended these ceiling boards be secured.

After consulting with our Parish and Finance Councils on this project, they approved my request and it was sent to the Diocese for final approval. Recently, I have received an approval letter from the Diocese allowing this project to be done. We hired NFW contractor to carry out this project at a cost of **\$21,885** with the agreement that all the dislodged ceiling boards will be secured with finishing nails rather than staples.

After Easter, on Monday April 17, this project will begin and is expected to be completed on Friday, April 21. I would like to thank the Buildings and Grounds Committee for their time and expertise in helping me to carry out this important project.

It would be greatly appreciated if everyone would make a sacrificial contribution to alleviate the financial burden for our parish. 
