Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,



This week we begin to enter Holy Week, the essence, the core, of our faith. It is a summarization of the whole history of human salvation and the summit of God's unconditional love for sinful humanity. The celebrations of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil are so rich in symbols, they signify the profound mysteries of God's salvific plan for us. As we commemorate the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ during Holy Week, we are called to join our own crosses with Jesus' cross in order to offer to God the Father a sacrifice for our own sins and the sins of others. We don't have to look for the crosses, they have already been in our lives, whether they are physical, mental, or moral. For this reason, Jesus said: "Take up your cross and follow me, for I am the way, the truth, and the life". If we join our crosses to his, He will show us the way to use our crosses for the sake of our souls and the souls of others. He will help us to understand and to accept the truth about suffering for the love of God and our neighbor. My brothers and sisters, let us make time for Jesus during this Holy Week. Let us come to experience Jesus' unconditional love for us and his infinite mercy in our lives. Let us come to feel the physical, psychological, and moral pains that Jesus has to endure. Let us come to receive salvation offered by Jesus on the cross so that we may live and live forever. Have a prayerful and blessed Holy Week.

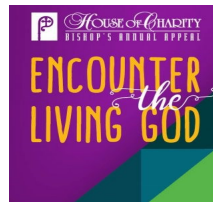

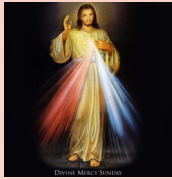
