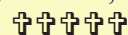

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



With Christmas approaching, the day we celebrate the mystery of the Incarnation of the Son of God, Jesus Christ, we are reminded by St. John the Baptist in today's Gospel: "Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight His paths." John was sent by God to prepare the way for His Son to enter into the world by proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. The same message of St. John the Baptist is sent to us during this Season of Advent as well. Each one of us need to ask ourselves: "How do I prepare my heart and soul for the Infant Jesus to enter at this Christmas 2017? How do I make straight his paths?"

First of all, we would not know how to make straight his paths unless we come to church to listen to His words and to participate in His sacrifice on the altar. 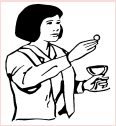

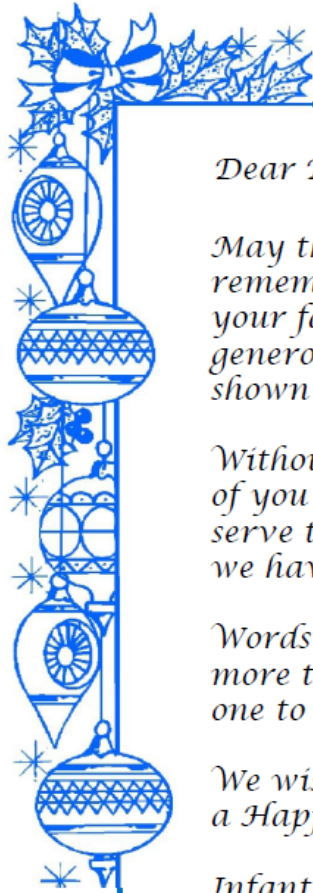
