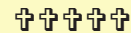

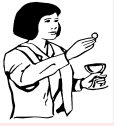

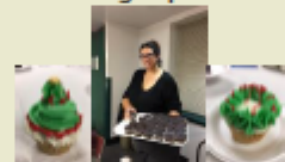

Everyone in attendance truly enjoyed this year's New York City trip on November 19, 2017.

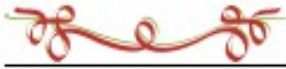
Our November meeting, Frost and Sip, featured Vanessa Messina sharing her expertise in decorating cupcakes.
