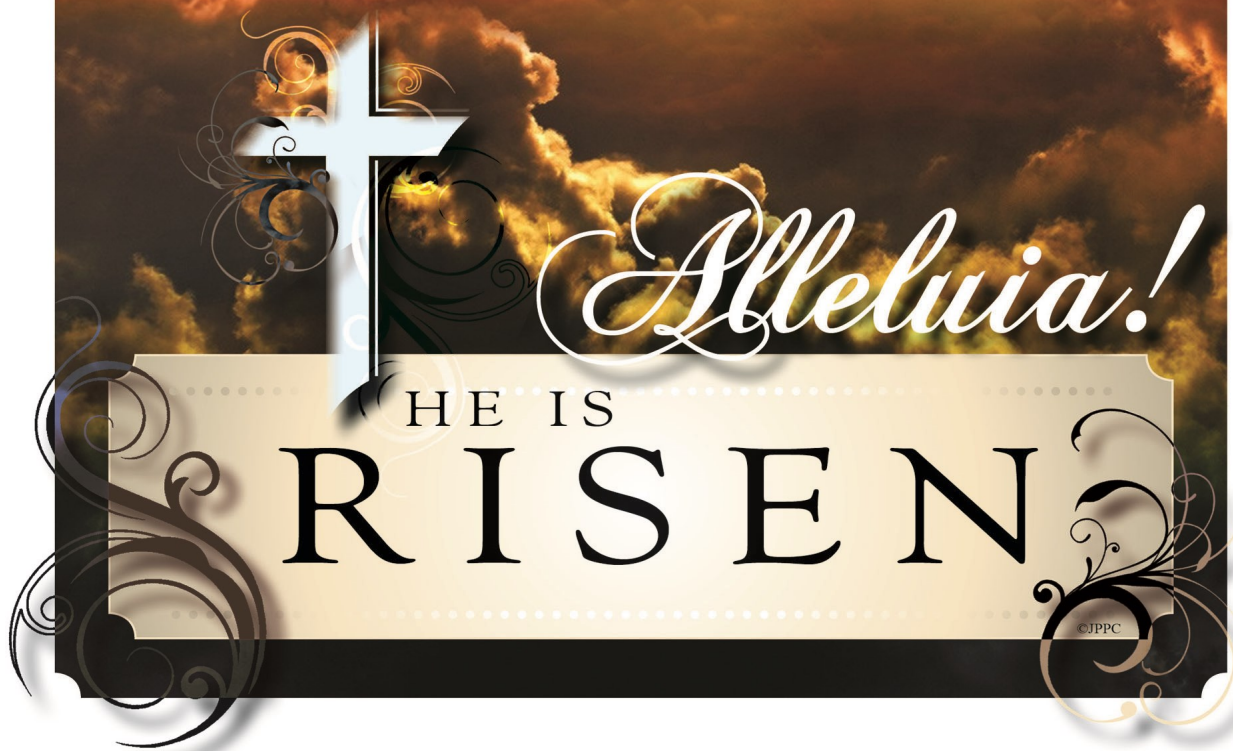

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,



Alleluia! Praise the Lord! Christ is risen! Death is defeated, humanity is redeemed, and the gates of eternal life is opened for all who believe in the risen Christ. The Resurrection of Christ is the answer for the longing in our hearts, the longing to live and to be happy forever. We are the Easter people and Alleluia is our song. Our faith in the resurrection of Christ is not based on the so called “myth”; but rather it is based on a solid foundation, the blood testimonies of Jesus’ disciples. 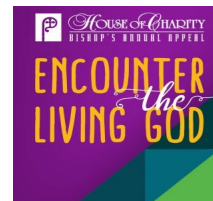


Family Prayer Crucifix for Vocations
