Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

Today's Gospel is hard for us to accept and even harder for us to put into practice. While our sinful human nature inclines to apply the principle: "an eye for an eye, a tooth for a tooth to all aspects of life", Our Lord Jesus taught us the opposite: "When someone strikes you on your right cheek, turn



the other one as well". "An eye for an eye" is a cycle of revenge, retaliation, it is a cycle of evil which was defeated by the sacrificial death of our Redeemer, Jesus Christ on the cross. Imagine that, if Jesus applied this "principle" to all of us, then no one could escape eternal damnation. Today, Jesus needs someone to "co-sacrifice" with Him in order to stop this cycle of evil which is still occurring in families, communities, and in the world. This "someone" might be national leaders, clergy, religious, laity, husbands, wives, mothers, fathers, sons, daughters, neighbors, or friends. Just like the way of the cross was the only way for Jesus to redeem us, "turn another cheek" is also the only way to put an end to this cycle of evil in our lives and in the lives of others. Let each one of us be a helping hand for Jesus, be that "someone" who "turns another cheek" by not seeking evil for evil; but rather seeking peaceful solution, reconciliation, forgiveness, and conversion of sinners. There will be a 7 PM Mass at St. Margaret Church during Lent beginning Ash Wednesday and ending Palm Sunday.




