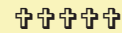

**Family Prayer Crucifix for Vocations**

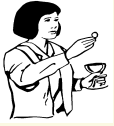


