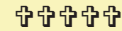

This week reminds us of the Anniversary of the Supreme Court decision, Roe vs. Wade (1973), which legalized abortion in our country. Encountering this Anniversary, the Church in the United States is calling for a Day of Prayer for the protection of unborn children. In response to this noble call, our parish will hold a Mass for Life at 7:00 PM at St. Margaret Church sponsored by our Knights of Columbus. The culture of death seems to be invading our culture today, it has become as a “best” solution to all human problems. However, the reality is that the culture of death is not a solution at all; it is a destruction of life. Life itself is created and given by God, the Creator of all life. The fact is that, even with the advance of science and technology in today’s world, human beings still cannot create or even restore a “dead flower” to life. God must have a reason when He creates a new life, He must also have a reason to keep life even, in some circumstances, when some wrongly defined as “no quality of life”. The act of abortion or euthanasia is intrinsically evil which means evil in itself, since it is violating the Supreme Authority and Holy Will of the Creator.
