#### **GREETINGS FROM FATHER STEVE**

I am excited about being part of Infant Jesus Parish. The parish is known for being very much alive, and that has been confirmed for me since I have been here.




#### **COME LET US ADORE HIM**



#### St. John Vianney (1786-1859)

Ordained a priest in 1815 and later made the parish priest of Ars, he is commonly known as the "Cure of Ars". His reputation grew as a confessor and director of souls throughout the Christian world so much that he spent many hours every day in the confessional. He lived a life of torment and mortification which resulted in him having great patience. Saint John Vianney was a true child of God in his simplicity and performed many works of charity and love guiding God's lost sheep back to the fold. He passed away on August 4, 1859 which is his Feast Day.
