Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

In today's Gospel, Jesus tried to explain the Kingdom of God in human terms by using the images of treasure, pearl, and net:

"The Kingdom of heaven is like a treasure buried in the field..., the Kingdom of heaven is like a merchant searching for fine pearls..., the Kingdom of heaven is like a net thrown into the sea..." (Matt 13:44).

The reason why Jesus said the Kingdom of heaven was like this or that is because the Kingdom of Heaven is not a physical location here or there; but rather it is a state of being. When Jesus came down from heaven, he brought with him the Kingdom of God in his person; therefore the Kingdom of God is already here but not yet. It is already here because Jesus already came; however it does not come to its completion or is fully manifested until the second coming of Jesus Christ. The Kingdom which Jesus was talking about was the state of being living in loving communion with God. Indeed having God in our lives is like possessing a treasure or a fine pearl. It is undeniable truth that, if we have the whole world but do not have God in our lives, it means nothing, because the whole world will not go with us when God calls us home. Let us search for the eternal treasure, eternal pearl rather than the things which are here today and gone tomorrow. Let us invest our time, talents, and treasure in the eternal Kingdom as well rather than just invest our whole lives only in this earthly kingdom where nothing lasts forever. *-Fr. Joe Pham.*


#### WORLD YOUTH DAY-PANAMA 2019

#### St. John Vianney (1786-1859)


Ordained a priest in 1815 and later made the parish priest of Ars, he is commonly known as the "Cure of Ars". His reputation grew as a confessor and director of souls throughout the Christian world so much that he spent many hours every day in the confessional. He lived a life of torment and mortification which resulted in him having great patience. Saint John Vianney was a true child of God in his simplicity and performed many works of charity and love guiding God's lost sheep back to the fold. He passed away on August 4, 1859 which is his Feast Day.
