Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,



Today we celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost, the descent of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles after the Ascension of Jesus Christ, which also marks the end of the Easter Season. The word “Pentecost” is from the Greek word meaning fifty days, in other words, fifty days from Easter Sunday. Pentecost Sunday is often misunderstood as the “Birthday of the Church”. Theologically, it is not at Pentecost that the Church was born; but rather the Church was born from the wounded side of Jesus on the cross. Just like the old Eve was born from the side of the old Adam, the New Eve, the Church, was born from the side of the New Adam, Jesus Christ nailed on the cross. What happened at Pentecost was that it marked the beginning of the manifestation of the Church to the whole world. The descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles gave them the gifts needed to proclaim the Good News of the Gospel of Christ and to manifest the Bride of Christ, the Church, to the whole world. The first gift given by the Holy Spirit to the Apostles was the gift of speaking different languages which meant everyone with different races and tongues would be able to understand them. The messages they spoke were so powerful that, on that day alone, thousands of people became believers. It was by the gifts and power of the Holy Spirit that the Apostles were so courageous in preaching the truths revealed by Jesus Christ and also were so powerful and effective in converting the people. Today the Holy Spirit is still working in every one of us if we are willing to open ourselves to the power and guidance of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit will empower us not to be afraid to speak the truths and live the truths in our lives, also the Holy Spirit will help us to change ourselves and to convert others effectively. Let us all pray to the Holy Spirit: “Come, Holy Spirit and renew the face of the earth”. -Fr. Joe Pham

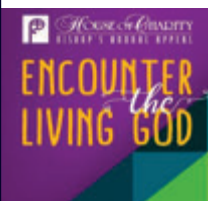
