Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,



Today's Gospel tells us about the Transfiguration of our Lord Jesus Christ up on the mountain. The Transfiguration occurred before Jesus' passion in order to serve as a "reinforcement" for the faith of His disciples, especially for Peter, James, and John who witnessed the "Glorious Jesus". Before His suffering and death, Jesus wanted to give Peter, James and John a glimpse of His heavenly glory, and a taste of being in His divine presence so that, in time of trial, they might still be faithful to the end. When witnessing the glorious Christ, Peter was so over excited about the heavenly light, and also the delightfulness of being in the presence of the "glorious Jesus" blew his mind off to the point that he did not know what he was saying: "Lord, it is good that we are here. If you wish, I will make three tents here, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah". Instead of responding to Peter's question, Jesus told Peter and the other disciples: "Let us come down from the mountain and build the three crosses for yourselves first". They did not know that they must come down first and carry their crosses upward to the transfigured mountain in order to stay up there forever. Let us carry our crosses, whether they are physical, mental, or moral crosses, up to the Transfigured Mountain. This journey even though sometimes it seems like a long, rough, crooked, or steep journey; but when reaching this mountain top, the glorious Jesus will be up there waiting for us, He will embrace us and say: "Well done my faithful servant, come to my Father's house prepared for you". - *Fr. Joe*

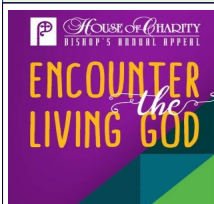

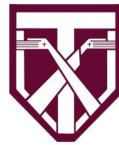

Bishop Dennis Sullivan Grants Dispensation from the Obligation to Abstain from Meat on March 17 in the Diocese of Camden

In accord with the Code of Canon Law, Bishop Dennis Sullivan has granted a dispensation to all Roman Catholics in the Diocese of Camden from the obligation to abstain from meat on March 17, 2017, the Feast Day of Saint Patrick.

However, in order to maintain the solemn spirit of the Holy Season of Lent, Bishop Sullivan asks Catholics within the Diocese of Camden, who choose to utilize this dispensation from meat abstinence, to instead either make another appropriate sacrifice on the day itself or to abstain from meat on another weekday during the Second Week of Lent.

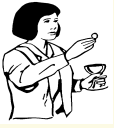
