Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

On Monday March 20th, the whole church will celebrate the Feast of St. Joseph, the Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Traditionally, St. Joseph's Feast is celebrated on March 19th; however, because this year it falls on Sunday, it is transferred to Monday March 20th. This Feast was honored



since the end of the 10th century and declared Patron Saint of the Universal Church in 1870 by Pope Pius IX. We don't have much information about St. Joseph in the Biblical text. However, according to the Scripture, St. Joseph was chosen by God, just like the Blessed Virgin Mary, to cooperate with God in His salvific plan for humanity. He was chosen to be the spouse of Mary and the foster father of Jesus Christ. He was known for his righteousness because he did not want to expose Mary to shame and to the law which would have led her to be stoned to death due to "adultery". Like Mary, St. Joseph was totally obedient to God's will for him by receiving Mary and her child, Jesus, into his care. He raised and nurtured Jesus through his hard labor as a carpenter. For this reason, He is truly deserved to be called Patron Saint of the Universal Church who would defend and protect the Church in time of difficulty as he protected Jesus when King Herod tried to kill the Infant Jesus. 


