Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

Recently, when celebrating the Sacrament of Penance for the children of both St. Margaret Regional School and the Religious Education Program, one thing that has saddened me a lot was that many of them confessed missing Mass many times on Sundays. Since they have been taught to keep the



"Lord's Day" by attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation, they felt so bad, even terrified every time they missed Sunday Mass. We know that they did not go to Mass not because of their own faults; but because nobody drove them to Church. As parents and guardians, we should make every effort to care not just for the physical well-being of our children but also for their spiritual well-being as well. For the sake of the children's spirituality and faith formation, they need to be encouraged to pray daily and to attend Sunday Mass regularly. As children need to go to school to learn about this world, they need to go to Church also in order to learn about God, Jesus, and to live Jesus in their lives. While education is so important for young people on earth, the spiritual formation is far more essential for their eternal lives in heaven. Indeed we are living in a busy world today, our weekend schedules may be packed; however, if we just try to make an hour for Mass on Sunday, we would never know that hour might make a difference in our lives: It might transform our physical and spiritual weariness into refreshment, it might replace our anxiety with peace, and also it might ease all other burdens occuping our lives. As Jesus said: "Come to me, all you who are weary and find life burdensome, and I will refresh you." (Matt 11:28). Let's bring the children to Mass, let them be nurtured by the Bread of Life and be healed and touched by Jesus Christ our Savior, for they are so vulnerable who indeed need the divine protection and direction the most. *-Fr.
