Throughout the liturgical calendar, the Church celebrates the mystery of human salvation beginning from the Birth of Christ, His Paschal Mystery (Christ's suffering, death, and resurrection), and finally the Triumphant Kingship of Christ. This Sunday we honor and recognize the Kingship of Christ as the King of the universe, the King of heaven and earth, the King of kings, Lord of lords, and ultimately the King of love. Unlike other earthly kings, our King, Jesus Christ, rules His subjects not by authority and power; but rather by love, compassion, and mercy. Unlike other kings, Christ our King came to serve and not to be served, He came to save and not to condemn. Unlike other kings, Christ the King sacrificed and died for his subjects. This is the kind of King we are honoring and worshipping. We submit our whole being to Him. We want Him to rule over us, and we long to live in his Kingdom, the Kingdom of love, the Kingdom of eternal life and happiness. Let us bring Christ the King into our own lives and the lives of our loved ones by coming to worship Him every Sunday, by bringing and encouraging our loved ones to attend the banquet of the King prepared on the Altar for all. 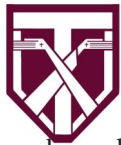

PRAYER FOR PERSECUTED CHRISTIANS

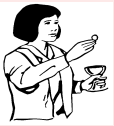
