Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



In today's Gospel, Jesus was asked by the Pharisees whether they should pay the census tax to Caesar or not? Jesus responded: "Whose image is this and whose inscription?" They replied: "Caesar's". Then Jesus said to them: "Repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God". By saying that, Jesus was referring Caesar as the "earthly things". The things that we labor all day and night for: shelter, food, clothes, careers, social status, fame, wealth, etc. These things occupy all our time and drain all our energy to the point that we feel so assaulted at the end of the day. The problem is that we often "over repay" what belongs to "Caesar", and fail to "repay" what is due to God. Remember, we are created in the image and likeness of God; thus our whole person "body and soul" is belonging to God. Meanwhile, our souls were also imprinted with an indelible mark, the (inscription), of the Blessed Trinity at our baptism: The Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. There are so many ways and opportunities for each of us to repay what belongs to God.
