There will be a 7:00 PM Mass at St. Margaret Church during Lent, Monday through Wednesday, beginning February 19th and ending March 28th..

In the Diocese of Camden, as in the Church universal, Ash Wednesday is to be observed as a day of penance, fasting, and prayer. As a day of fast and abstinence, Catholics from the age of 18 to the age of 60 are bound to the mandate to fast; Catholics over the age of 14 are seriously bound to observe the abstinence from meat.

Lenten fasting allows for a single "normal" meal. Sustenance through the day is permitted but the quantity of food for this sustenance is not to equal or exceed the amount of food taken in the single normal meal.

As a diocese, we recognize and affirm the expression of human love that is celebrated by the customs associated with Valentine's Day. However the mandate that we observe fast and abstinence on Ash Wednesday supersede any secular celebration and may not be dispensed. You may wish to celebrate with your Valentine prior to Ash Wednesday (much in the way certain cultures celebrate *Carnivale* or *Mardi Gras*) so that the solemn penitential nature is not compromised.

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,



This Wednesday we will celebrate Ash Wednesday, the beginning of Lenten Season. Although Ash Wednesday is not a Holy Day of obligation; it is a “Holy Day of Restoration”. The ashes remind us of who we are, we are mortal, we are sinners, we are dust and unto dust we shall return. When we receive the ashes, the minister makes the sign of the cross on our foreheads by saying “repent and believe in the Gospel”. Repent and believe in the Gospel is the only way to transform our mortality into immortality, the only way to change our “nothingness” into “preciousness”, and the only way to change our eternal damnation into eternal beatific vision of God in heaven. Ash Wednesday helps us to be in touch with our sinfulness and weaknesses so that we would have in our hearts a longing to change for a better priest, religious, husband, wife, mom, dad, son, daughter, brother, sister, and neighbor. Ash Wednesday invites us to follow Jesus who is the way, the truth, and the life, who would deliver us out of slavery of sin, addition, hopelessness, misery, suffering, and ultimately eternal death. Ash Wednesday empowers us to journey with Jesus faithfully to Calvary, the “hill of death” for Jesus; but it is the “hill of life” for all. Let us take time to worship Jesus on Ash Wednesday, let us come to ask Jesus to rescue us from our spiritual death, and let us come to ask Jesus “remember me when you come into your kingdom”. Ash Wednesday is not a Holy Day of Obligation; it is indeed a Holy Day of Restoration from Death to Life. . -Fr. Joe Pham

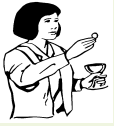

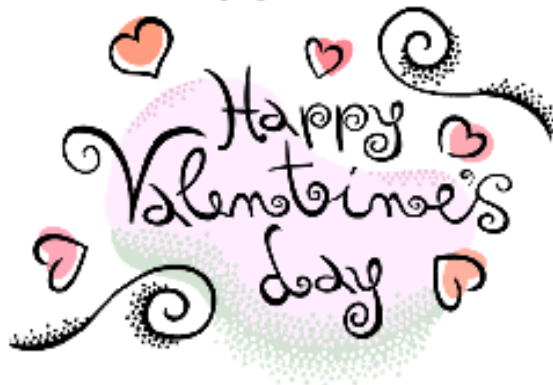

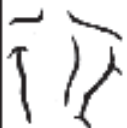
