Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



As we are entering the liturgical Holy Season of Lent, the Season in which Jesus invites each one of us to join our physical, emotional, and spiritual crosses with his as sacrificial offerings to God the Father for our own sins and the sins of others. Today's Gospel tells us about the temptation of Jesus Christ which reminds us of our own battles with Satan every day of our lives as well. The word "Satan" means deceiver or liar. Indeed, Satan tried to deceive Jesus not to go to Calvary. The tempter cleverly tempted Jesus by whispering into Jesus' mind all forms of delusion and deception of power. The deceiver tempted Jesus to use his divine power to change the sinfulness of human hearts instead of using his sacrificial love which was the way of the cross. Jesus wanted to use his redemptive love to gain our hearts, he wanted us to change our sinful way of living not by fear but by love, he wanted the submission of our hearts and souls, and there was only one way to do this, the way to Calvary. Let each one of us take these forty days of Lent as a spiritual renewal by being in touch with our true selves and souls so that the tempter would not have a chance to deceive us from the truth taught by our Lord Jesus Christ.

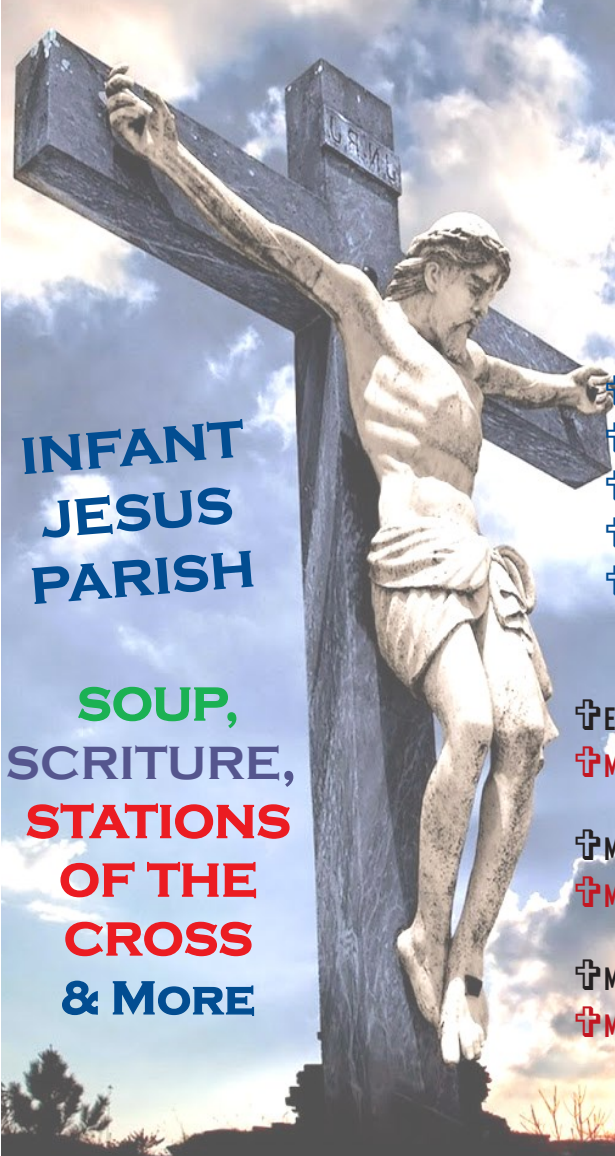

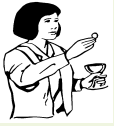
