Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In today's Gospel, St. John the Baptist pointed out Jesus to two of his disciples: "Behold, the lamb of God. The two disciples heard what he said and followed Jesus." After encountering Jesus himself, Andrew who was one of the two went to tell his brother, Simon Peter: "We have found the Messiah" and he brought him to Jesus.

The reason for John the Baptist's existence was to go ahead of Jesus, to proclaim his coming, and finally to point him out to others when he came. Andrew, John's disciple, also learned from his master and did the same by bringing his brother, Simon Peter to Jesus.

Like St. John the Baptist and St. Andrew, the purpose of our existence is to point out Jesus to others, to bring others to Jesus. Both John and Andrew did not just talk about Jesus or tell others about Jesus, they showed Jesus in their actions. John the Baptist went into the desert, using his mortification as a sign of repentance for the forgiveness of sin. His way of living drew people to him and, at last, when Jesus came, he pointed him out to them: "This is the one whom I am not worthy to untie his sandals." Also, Andrew went to look for Peter and brought him to Jesus.

Therefore, let us use all the God-given means of our existence: the charitable work of our hands, the nice, kind, and inspired words of our tongues, the compassionate and loving care of our hearts, the understanding and tolerance of our minds, and the life of our sacrificial service, to point Jesus out to those around us, to bring them back and closer to Jesus. Today more than ever, Jesus needs more John the Baptists and Andrews in our families, our parish communities, and indeed in the whole world. **-Fr. Joe Pham**
