

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The theme in today's Gospel is about the call to discipleship. When Jesus saw Simon and his brother Andrew casting their nets into the sea, he called them to follow him: "Come after me, and I will make



you fishers of men." The word "disciple" means "learner". Jesus called Simon and Andrew to follow him, and not just follow him passively, but rather they should actively learn from his teachings about "the way, the truth, and the life". Unfortunately when facing difficulty and danger, they failed terribly one by one, one betrayed, one denied, and the rest ran away, they all abandoned Jesus when he was crucified on the cross. After his resurrection, thanks to Jesus Christ for his unconditional love and infinite mercy, he gave them a second chance to be his disciples again. Empowering by the fact that their Master came back to life, the disciples set their lives constantly on the mission until their lives were ended in martyrdom. Through Baptism, we too are called to be active disciples of Jesus Christ, to be constantly on the mission of building and expanding the Kingdom of God on earth by our words and deeds. Like the disciples, we often fail to follow the footsteps of Jesus, especially when things do not go smoothly in our lives or the way we want them to be; however Jesus is always giving us a second chance to gain back our privilege of discipleship. Following the footsteps of Jesus Christ means Jesus' concern is our concern and his mission is our mission. As Jesus laid down the foundation for the Church by his own blood, now he needs each one of us to sustain and nurture his missionary Church on earth through our prayerful support and sacrifices. Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As you may have heard, a major campaign is underway at Infant Jesus. *Catholic Strong*, the Campaign for the Catholic Community of South Jersey, is seeking to secure a minimum of \$50 million, which will primarily benefit our local parishes. Seventy percent of the funds raised through this effort (a total of \$35 million) will be allocated for parish needs and thirty percent (a total of \$15 million) will fund the diocese's coordination and support of various ministries. The mission of this campaign is to ensure that our parishes are financially stable and allow the diocese the opportunity to address long-term and extraordinary needs so that our Church will have the strength and stability to serve future generations of Catholics.

70% of the campaign funds that we raise toward our parish goal will be used for the following parish needs:

*	 Enhancing Our Parish Community – Saint John Vianney Church Repave sidewalks and curbs; repave parking lots and driveways (\$70K) Renovate sacristy, repair stain glass windows, and install new carpeting (\$50K) Build church canopy to protect parishioners from inclement weather condition extending over the driveway covering the main entrance to the church (\$20K) Create Parish Maintenance Fund (\$15K) 	\$155,000
*	 Enhancing Our Parish Community – Saint Margaret Church Repave sidewalks and curbs; repave parking lots and driveways (\$140K) Complete interior church renovations, including repairing the sanctuary floor, installing new carpeting, renovating and updating pews, improving church lighting, and painting the interior of the church (\$165K) Build church canopy to protect parishioners from inclement weather conditions extending over the driveway covering the main entrance to the church (\$180K) Create Parish Maintenance Fund (\$15K) 	\$500,000*
٠	Programs and Ministries Grow and expand our youth and family ministry as well as our nursing ministry, allowing for additional resources.	\$150,000

The remaining funds will be allocated for Catholic education, social service outreach, and evangelization and faith formation efforts across South Jersey.

In the coming weeks, we will share further details about the campaign with all of you. It is my hope that our entire community will join together and participate in "Catholic Strong" for the future of our parish. I am profoundly grateful for your continued prayers and support.
