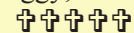

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



As you have already heard and read about the Diocesan Catholic Strong Campaign, I hope that each one of us would understand and recognize the pastoral needs of our future generations and the need of sustaining our worship facilities. I would earnestly like to ask each one of you to pray seriously about this, to see how much you can sacrifice for this noble cause. The purpose of this capital campaign is to sustain the stability of our parish's facilities and to create ministries needed for the future of our local church and the Church of Camden. Therefore, it is our obligation to continue maintaining our churches for our children and grandchildren to worship and to form new ministries needed for the spiritual well-being of our future generations. We should be thankful to our predecessors of St. Margaret and St. John Vianney churches who built and sustained both churches so that we would have a place to worship today. Our parish's assigned Catholic Strong goal is \$1,150,000, plus this year's House of Charity goal (\$164,711 – 10%) \$148,240; thus the total amount needed to be raised is \$1,298,240. It seems like a lot; but, with the love of God and His church, especially for the future of our children and grandchildren's faith, together we will make it happen. We have to continue the legacies of our predecessors' sacrifices and generosity at both churches. Our Bishop someday will be retired and gone, Fr. Steve and I someday will be transferred and gone, you as parishioners of this parish will someday too be gone; however we don't want to see our churches and ministries gone. We want our children and grandchildren to have a place to worship as our predecessors did for us. The truth is that the money we spend for the things in this life will be gone forever; however the financial sacrifices we offer to Jesus for the good of his church and of his people will remain and be recorded forever in the Book of eternal life in heaven. May the divine grace of God help us to be selfless and open our generous hearts to the evangelical needs of the future of our parish. As a priest, I would have many good excuses not to give: "I don't make much money, I have already sacrificed my whole life for the church, I have already been serving God's church and His people etc."; however if everyone would say the same thing like me, then our parish would not have what we would have now: St. Margaret and St. John Vianney churches to worship and to celebrate the Sacraments. "The more you give, the more will be given to you" said Jesus-*Fr. Joe Pham*

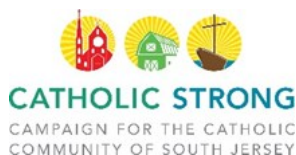

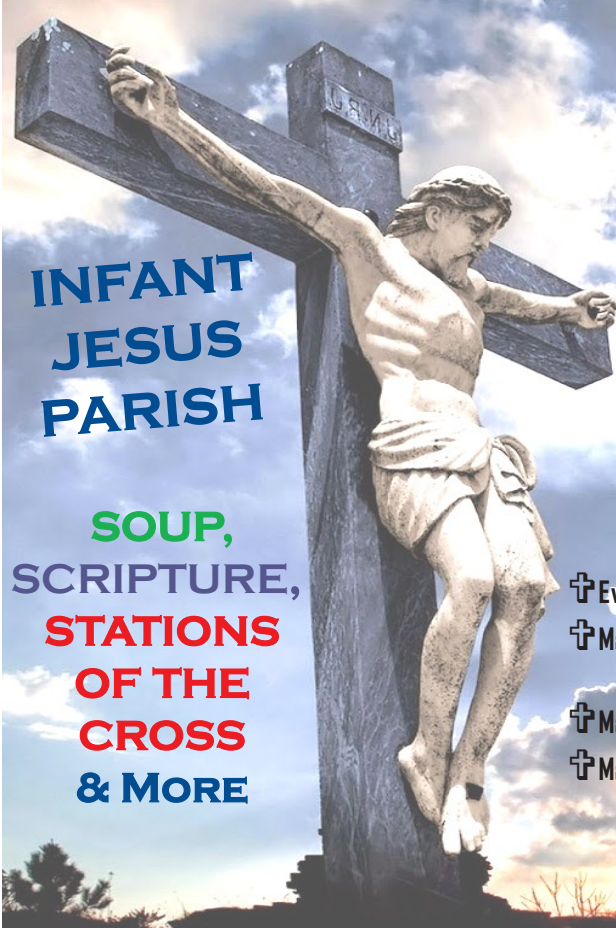

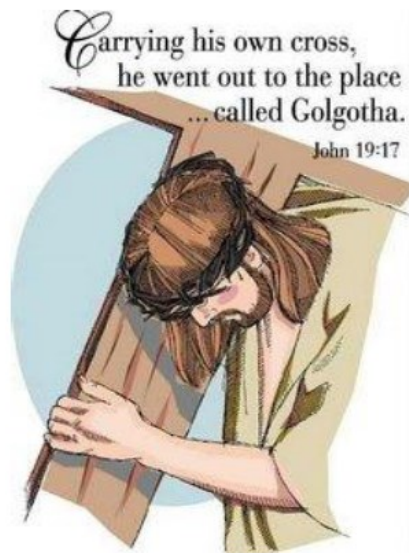
