Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

When reflecting on all the blessings we have inherited in our parish, we thank God for the extraordinary sacrifices of our previous generations of parishioners who built and established St. Margaret and St. John Vianney Churches and Parishes which eventually were merged in 2010 to become Infant Jesus Parish. As later generation parishioners, we indeed owe those who sacrificed before so that we would have a place called church and parish. Each one of us have a moral obligation to sustain what we have already inherited and to continue building up the future of our parish. The Catholic Strong Campaign is an opportunity for each one of us to be part of our parish ownership. It is truly our own parish, our children's parish, and our grandchildren's parish where all have received Baptism, Holy Communion, Confirmation, Matrimony, and Christian Burial. This Campaign is not about fund-raising; it is about "heart-raising". Truly when giving a sacrificial gift to this Campaign, we are raising our hearts to God for our love of Him and also raising our hearts for our love of the future generations of Catholics at Infant Jesus Parish. The truth is that we cannot just keep spending, using, and not giving or fixing. The projects and pastoral needs below are totally dependent on our generous giving:

- Enhancing our Parish Community- St. John Vianney Church (\$140,000)
 - 1- Replacing sidewalks and curbs, repave parking lots and driveways (\$70,000)
 - 2- Renovate sacristy, repair stain glass windows, and install new carpeting (\$50,000)
 - 3- Build church canopy to protect parishioners from inclement weather conditions extending over the main entrance to the church (\$20,000)
- Enhancing our Parish Community- St. Margaret Church (\$485,000)
 - 1- Replace sidewalks and curbs; repave parking lots and driveways (\$140,000)
 - 2- Complete interior church renovations, including replacing the sanctuary floor, installing new carpeting, renovating and updating pews, improving church lighting, and painting the interior of the church (\$165,000)
 - 3- Build church canopy to protect parishioners from inclement weather conditions extending over the driveway and the main entrance to the church (\$180,000)
- Programs and Ministries (\$150,000)
 - 1- Grow and expand our Youth and Family Ministry as well as our Parish Nurse Ministry, allowing for additional resources
- Create Emergency Parish Maintenance Fund (\$30,000)

I pray that every parishioner/family would sacrifice a gift and be part of this moral obligation and heart-raising campaign.-Fr. Joe Pham
