In today's Second Reading, St. John says: "Children, let us love not in word or speech but in deed and truth." 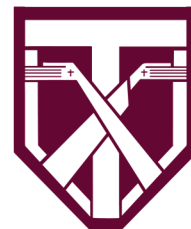
