

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today, with the whole Church, we celebrate the Birth of St. John the Baptist. St. John the Baptist was chosen to be born into this world for only one purpose: "to prepare the way of the Lord". His life was



meaningful only if he would fulfill his mission as the one who was "crying out in the desert", the one who heralded the way for the coming of Jesus Christ. St. John the Baptist indeed accomplished his mission entrusted to him so well that he was not only the one who was "crying out in the desert"; but also the one who poured out his own blood to testify to the truth. His birth prefigured the birth of Christ to come, his mission preluded to the mission of the "Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world", and his death testified to the true God, Jesus Christ. 
