It has been six months since our parish began the Campaign of Catholic Strong which was requested by Bishop Sullivan. As the shepherd of the diocese, the Bishop has a moral obligation to sustain



and strengthen the future of each parish's ministries in the diocese. Looking into the future of our parish particularly, we definitely need this campaign in order to maintain the stability of our places of worship and our pastoral ministries for the future generations of Catholics who are our children and grandchildren. 
