Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



Today's Gospel invites each one of us to be in touch with the deepest longings in our hearts. The Gospel tells us that the people came out from all the towns and villages to hear Jesus's teachings, they hungered to see him and to hear his words. As a compassionate and caring shepherd, Jesus was moved with pity for them because they were like "sheep without a shepherd". These people, deep down in their hearts, were seeking and longing for something that no one else could give them, no one else could satisfy their deepest desires except Jesus Christ. The more they listened to Jesus' words, the more they felt attached to him, the more they felt fulfilled. Like the people in today's Gospel, we too are longing for something that no human being would be able to give us, nothing on earth would be able to fulfill us. Everyday, we long to be healthy, to be happy, and ultimately to be eternal; unfortunately, these objects of our longings are impossible to achieve in this earthly life. Therefore, where can we go to find them? Who can fulfill or satisfy our deepest longings?

In reality, the whole world is hungry and thirsty: Some parts of the world hunger for the basic necessities of life, some hunger for justice, for peace, for freedom and human rights. However, when these hungers or longings are fulfilled and satisfied, other kinds of "hunger" arise: hunger for greed, for oppression, and for power. Indeed, there is always a constant longing in the human heart. This longing is an eternal longing therefore only eternal things would be able to fulfill and satisfy it. Only Jesus Christ is eternal, yesterday, today and forever. Only Jesus Christ has the words of eternal things, only Jesus Christ can satisfy the human heart, the heart that He Himself created. 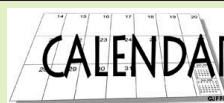

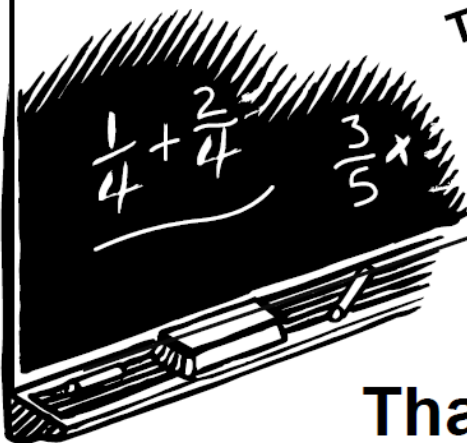

St. John Vianney (1786-1859)

Ordained a priest in 1815 and later made the parish priest of Ars, he is commonly known as the "Cure of Ars". His reputation grew as a confessor and director of souls throughout the Christian world so much that he spent many hours every day in the confessional. He lived a life of torment and mortification which resulted in him having great patience. Saint John Vianney was a true child of God in his simplicity and performed many works of charity and love guiding God's lost sheep back to the fold. He passed away on August 4, 1859 which is his Feast Day.
