#### Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Gospel today is about the miracle of the multiplication of the five loaves and two fish. As a compassionate and loving Jesus, he did not only care for the salvation of people's souls; but he also cared for their "daily bread" as well. The Gospel tells us that the people left their homes, towns and villages to go searching for Jesus in a deserted place. When seeing the people coming from afar, Jesus was moved by their spiritual and physical hungers. In order to feed this large crowd, Jesus asked for the boy's charity by sacrificing his five loaves and two fish. Remember, Jesus could have created more than enough bread and fish to feed thousands of the people there without taking the "five loaves and two fish" from the boy; however he wanted to teach us a lesson of love and charity: Where there is love there would be miracles, where there is charity there would be plenty. By the sacrifice of the boy, thousands of people were fed, the impossible became possible.





#### St. John Vianney (1786-1859)

Ordained a priest in 1815 and later made the parish priest of Ars, he is commonly known as the "Cure of Ars". His reputation grew as a confessor and director of souls throughout the Christian world so much that he spent many hours every day in the confessional. He lived a life of torment and mortification which resulted in him having great patience. Saint John Vianney was a true child of God in his simplicity and performed many works of charity and love guiding God's lost sheep back to the fold. He passed away on August 4, 1859 which is his Feast Day.


