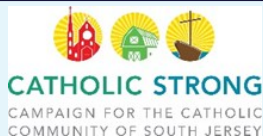

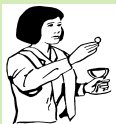

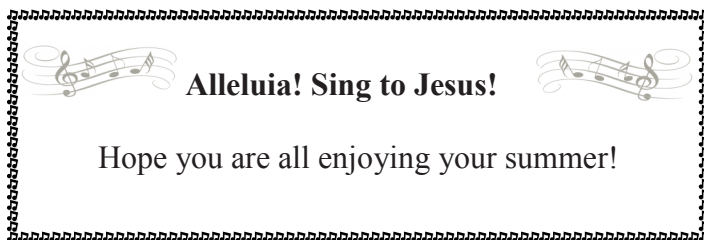
DIOCESAN MARIAN PILGRIMAGE OCTOBER 13, 2018

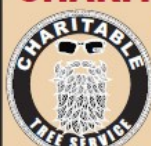
