Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



Jesus said in today's Gospel: "Do not work for food that perishes but for the food that endures for eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you". These words of Jesus should serve as a daily reminder for all of us rather than just only for today liturgy. As a matter of fact, we spend our whole lives laboring for only perishable things, the things which are here today and gone tomorrow. Who we were and what we had in the past are now history, who we are and what we have now is in the process of passing away, and who we will be and what we will have are coming; but soon they will be fading away as well. At the end, there will be nothing left even our own lives. This is the reality of our earthly life. Therefore, the Gospel today should be a wake up call for all of us, since it is easy for us to be emerged into these finite things on earth and forget to seek and work for the things that are eternal. After warning the people about the "food" that perishes, Jesus showed them the "eternal bread": "I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me will never hunger, and whoever believes in me will never thirst". Indeed having Jesus in our lives is having everything, the things that last forever and no one can take them away from us.

St. John Vianney, whose Feast Day we celebrate on Sunday as one of our church's patron Saints, spent his whole life in seeking and working for the things that last forever. Recognizing Jesus as the "bread of life", St. John Vianney determined to follow the footsteps of Jesus in a radical way. On the path to the priesthood, St. John Vianney had faced many challenges and difficulties in his life as well as in his studies. Since, deep down in his heart, he desired to work for the things that last forever, he tirelessly and successfully persevered through all obstacles and trials which had jeopardized his path to the priesthood. Moreover, as a priest, he excelled in all virtues, especially the virtues of patience and compassion. Throughout his priestly life, he worked tirelessly in the confessional and through his penitential life for the salvation of souls. He spent his whole life laboring not for the perishable "bread" but for the eternal "bread". Like St. John Vianney, let us seek things that are eternal, let us labor for the salvation of our own souls and the souls of others, let us faithfully come to Jesus on the altar who is the one and only one who can satisfy our infinite thirst and fulfill our infinite hunger. **-Fr. 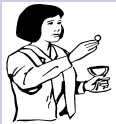
