#### Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In today's Second Reading from St. Paul, we perhaps would find it hard to believe or accept his Paston's Desk teachings on the spousal relationship. As he said: "Wives should be subordinate to their husbands as to the Lord". However, if we discontinue reading his teaching on the "husbands", we would really misunderstand St. Paul's teaching on the roles of husbands and wives. After his teaching on the "wives", St. Paul turned to the "husbands" saying: "Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ loved the church and handed himself over for her to sanctify her". Therefore, "husbands", before you expect your "wives to be submissive to you, you have to die for them first just like Christ sacrificed for the Church. The word "subordinate" used by St. Paul here implied "submissive love" just like the Church is submissive to Christ in love. Indeed, if a husband selflessly sacrifices for his wife, there would be no reason that his wife would not love him submissively. However, how many husbands would understand this teaching and truly live this teaching in their marriages? As Christ loved the Church first and sacrificed for her first, so do husbands. The love between husband and wife is truly a reflection of the love between Christ and the Church; therefore it is sacred, selfless, sublime, and profound. Most of the broken marriages are caused by self-love, and because of this love of oneself, it would lead to carelessness, inattentiveness, and indifference to the other spouse's physical and spiritual well-being. Let us pray for married couples that husbands and wives would learn from St. Paul's teaching on spousal love and be willing to love each other as Christ Jesus loved the Church. -Fr. Joe Pham


