Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today's Gospel reminds us of how we should live our Christian life as faithful followers of Jesus. Pastor's Desk "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me. For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake and that of the gospel will save it" said Jesus. Following Jesus means walking a "narrow road" on which not many would like to travel. Like St. Peter in today's Gospel, we don't like to hear about suffering and death, we don't like to hear about illness and aging, sorrow and pain, betrayal and hurt, rejection and destruction, etc. Unfortunately, whether we like them or not, they are the "crosses" which we carry and experience in our daily lives. As faithful followers of Christ, we don't like "the cross", we don't like suffering, we accept it, just as Jesus accepted his passion in the Garden and offered it to God the Father as a sacrifice for our salvation. We should not try to save our earthly lives by turning away from God, by blaming God for the crosses in our lives, by causing and imposing crosses on others or by making others' crosses more heavier. Instead, "losing our lives for the sake of Christ and the Gospel" by joining our crosses to Jesus' cross. Offer to God the Father our crosses as sacrifices for our own sins and the sins of others. Use these means and blessings given by God to alleviate, lessen, or soften the crosses of our loved ones and those around us. In this way, we are truly living our faith, making our faith alive and shine. We must live faith and not just have faith: "What good is it? So also faith of itself, if it does not have works, is dead" said St. James. -Fr. Joe Pham
