Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



As our nation observes Labor Day this weekend, we, as Christians, should celebrate it not just as a civil event but also as a religious significance as well. From the beginning of creation, God intended to create a perfect world with everything in it including humanity; however human beings misused the God-given power of free will therefore sin entered the world and human labor was one of the consequences of this original sin: "Because of what you have done, the ground will be under a curse. You will have to work hard all your life to make it produce enough food for you". (Gen 3:17). However, thanks be to God for his unconditional love and infinite mercy, he sent his only Son, Jesus Christ, to redeem humanity and to reconcile all creation to himself.
