Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As of today every parish family should have already received my appeal letter for the Catholic Strong Paston's Desk Campaign, some also received a reminder letter as well. The most realistic way of putting our faith into action is to awaken in our hearts the spirit of loving and responsible stewardship. 
