Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today's Gospel reminds us of the two essential commandments of our religion which sum up all the Pastor's Desk "laws and prophets": "Hear, O Israel! The Lord our God is Lord alone! You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your souls, with all your minds, and with all your strength. The second is this: You shall love your neighbor as yourself". We know these two commandments by heart but we often just keep the first one and neglect the other. Every day, we have no problem to love God with our whole being; but we struggle to love others as ourselves. The reason why we have no difficulty to love God is because we can "use" him, we can get "something" from him which no human being would be able to give or do for us; whereas we cannot love everyone as ourselves since some of our "neighbors" do not give us anything, they even sometimes hurt us or cause us troubles. This kind of love is called "conditional love", the love that expects a return. However, if we want to believe and live this kind of love in our lives, then we should not expect God to love us unconditionally. We just cannot say: "Jesus, I love you with my whole being"; but we rather have to prove it by living the commandment of "love your neighbor as yourself" as well. Remember, after the resurrection, the Risen Christ encountered St. Peter by questioning him three times: "Peter, do you love me more than these?" After Peter's responses, Jesus three times commanded Peter: "Take care of my lambs and feed my sheep". This is exactly what Jesus expects from us to prove our love for him by taking care of his people, feed his people, and love his "neighbors". For this is the only way to prove that "you truly love me and not use me". -Fr. Joe Pham




