This Sunday, October 14<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 AM Mass, our Parish will celebrate the Feast Day of one of our patron Saints: St. Margaret Mary Alacoque. St. Margaret was born on July 22, 1647 in Burgundy,



France. As a young teenager, she developed a special devotion to the Blessed Sacrament. In 1671 she entered the Visitation Convent and began to experience visions of Christ when she was twenty. In the visions, she had received a series of revelations in which Christ informed her that she was His chosen instrument to spread the devotion of His Sacred Heart, she was also asked that the Feast of the Sacred Heart be established. She died on October 17, 1690 and was canonized in 1920. Seventy five years after her death, the devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus was officially recognized and approved by Pope Clement XIII in 1765. In celebrating her Feast, we pray that St. Margaret would inflame in our hearts a burning love and heartfelt gratitude to the Sacred Heart of Jesus Christ, the Heart that was, is, and will be painfully pierced through everyday by the sword of our sins. The Heart that has never been tired of loving and forgiving, the Heart that has never stopped thirsting for the astray souls. This Sacred Heart wants to talk "heart to heart" with each one of us, this Sacred Heart wants to be united "heart to heart" to the Sacred Heart of Christ as St. Margaret Mary Alacoque did? St. Margaret pray for us.




