Next Thursday and Friday November 1st and 2nd, the whole Church will celebrate the glory of All Pastor's Desk Saints and also commemorate All Souls, those who are still in the stage of purification. The reason why our Church celebrates All Saints and commemorates All Souls because our religion is a "communion religion". We are the living, our lives neither disconnect from the Saints in heaven nor from the dead. We are constantly living in union with the Saints who constantly intercede for us, the living, and for those who passed away in the presence of God. 

Man Up South Jersey: A Men's Spirituality Conference
