Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Paston's Desk Today's First Reading tells us about the creation of male and female who were joined together as husband and wife by God in marriage: "That is why a man leaves his father and mother and clings to his wife, and the two of them become one flesh." This indissoluble loving bond between husband and wife was confirmed by Jesus Christ in today's Gospel as well: "Therefore; what God has joined together, no human being must separate". For this reason, marital union is not merely a human union or social institution; but rather it is a sacred and indissoluble union. Indeed, marriage is rooted in the mystery of the Blessed Holy Trinity, it is a reflection of the dynamic loving union between the Three Persons of the Trinity. Husbands and wives are expected to live out the Trinitarian love in their marriages, the love of total sharing, total giving, and total sacrificing for each other. Unfortunately many young couples and even couples married for years still struggle everyday to make their marriages work. Sometimes husbands and wives think they really love each other but in reality they don't. Their love for each other is still selfish, they are not totally sharing yet, they are not totally giving to each other yet, and they are not ready to sacrifice for each other totally yet. They still keep something back to themselves; meanwhile they expect their "other-half" to share, to give and to sacrifice more for them. Every day husbands and wives need to question themselves "what more can I give, share, and sacrifice for my beloved?" Husbands and wives need to share, to give, to sacrifice first before expecting anything from the "other- half". If husbands and wives truly understand and live out the teaching of Jesus Christ: "Do unto others what you would like them do unto you", their marriages would not be broken or miserable; but rather their marriages would be joyful and happy marriages and dynamically loving unions.
