Food drives are extremely important to the St. Vincent de Paul Society and those we serve. They help fill the gaps of foods that are not frequently donated. You can make a difference. Your efforts to organize and conduct a food drive will provide nutritious, high quality food for your neighbors in

need and help with your community service hours.

Hunger doesn't take a holiday. While the holidays are typically the time when most lend a helping hand, hunger is a year-round issue for many in our area. NOW is the perfect time for your food drive.

Most Needed Items:

- **High-Protein:** meat (ham, spreads, stews, chicken); fish (tuna, salmon, sardines); vegetarian (nuts, seeds, peanut butter and other nut butters, and beans)
- Dairy: evaporated and powdered milk; puddings and custards; infant formula (plastic containers only)
 Fruits & Vegetables: canned fruit, canned vegetables, 100% fruit and vegetable juices, soups, sauces, and condiments.
- Breads & Cereals: breakfast cereals, rice, pasta, and muffin/bread mixes.
- Household Goods: (must be kept separate from food donations) diapers, paper products, and cleaning supplies and detergents.
- **Please Note:** We cannot accept previously opened containers, repackaged and homemade items, products dated 2005 or earlier, perishables (i.e. breads, pies, cakes, produce (fresh or frozen), glass bottles/containers, or aluminum soda cans.
- **Attached:** Is a sample of the flyer that can be attached to a plastic bag and given to neighbors with the information for collection. Bag can be brought to the rectory for placement in the food pantry.
