Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Thom the Pastor's Desk

Time is counting down as we get closer to the celebration of Christmas, the Birth of the Son of God, our Redeemer. Are we ready to celebrate the birth of our redemption, to rejoice as

God and humanity reconciled, and to open wide the door of our hearts for Jesus to enter? Indeed the Incarnation of God made man is the beginning of our redemption, our new birth in God's Kingdom, since through the union of God and man in the womb of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we all became adopted children of God. The Good News of God and humanity being reconciled and united has been proclaimed from generation to generation. For this reason our hearts must be rejoicing and widely opened in waiting for the Immanuel, God -with-us, to enter. Unfortunately, there are so many attractions and distractions which often take away the true meaning and the profound depth of Christmas. Our true peace and joy on the Birth of Christ does not depend on spectacular Christmas lights and trees, magnificent nativities or wonderful Christmas gifts; but rather our true peace and joy at Christmas depends on the divine truths revealed through the mystery of the Incarnation. Our true joy and peace acquired through the knowledge of being redeemed and not condemned, being united with our human sinful nature to the divine nature of God which made possible for us to be called children of God, and ultimately being promised eternal life and happiness in the heavenly kingdom. Let the peace and joy of Christmas replace our anxiety and weariness, sorrow and pain, hurt and hatred, greed and wrongful desire. Let us celebrate Christmas 2018 with firm conviction of joy and peace as St. Paul convinced in today's Second Reading: "Rejoice in the Lord always, I say it again, rejoice. Your kindness should be known to all. The Lord is near. Have no anxiety at all, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, make your requests known to God.
